- Last start was a 1:56.2f victory over nw3 competition at Harrah's Philadelphia on July 26
- Was fourth-placed-third in Pennsylvania Sire Stakes competition at The Meadows on May 20 and second in a division of the Pennsylvania Stallion Series on June 11 at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono
- Broke his maiden on May 5 at the Meadowlands in 1:54.2, which is his lifetime mark
- Was winless in eight starts as a 2-year-old, but he was second in Pennsylvania Sire Stakes events at The Meadows and Harrah's Philadelphia
- Sire Andover Hall was the odds-on choice in the 2002 Hambletonian, but broke stride early and did not finish. He would redeem himself later that August by winning the World Trotting Derby. Dam Secret Credit (Credit Winner) earned \$133,811 in her career and was a multiple-time New York Sire Stakes winner. She is also a half-sister to Berto Primo (Garland Lobell), who was ninth-placed-eighth in the 2006 Hambletonian
- Francisco Del Cid, a native of Guatemala, is a former exercise rider for Hall of Fame Thoroughbred trainer D. Wayne Lukas. He switched to harness racing in the late 1980s and has been active since. He had a small stable until joining with trainer Trond Smedshammer's operation
- Del Cid went back out on his own in late 2007 and enjoyed his best year in 2008, keyed by Diana Hall. She won the Moni Maker at The Red Mile, was third in the Del Miller Memorial, and fourth in the Hambletonian Oaks
- Del Cid has had one Hambletonian finalist, JJ Alex, who was seventh in 2014
- JJ Alex was co-owned by Mario Mazza, who also shares ownership of Stealth Hanover with Del Cid. Mazza also co-owns Hambletonian participant Sortie, who races for trainer Noel Daley
- Hanover Shoe Farms has won the most Hambletonians as a breeder with ten, the last coming in 2007 with Donato Hanover
